

Pan-Bedfordshire CSE & Missing Children and Young People Strategic Group: The overall purpose of the Pan Bedfordshire CSE/Missing Strategic Group is to monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the strategic and operational multi-agency response to Child Sexual Exploitation and Missing Children across Bedford Borough, Central Bedfordshire and Luton.
