

Priority 1: Prevention

- Prevention champions operating at board level in each of the 16 STP organisations
- Prevention Priority Board established to develop social prescribing model, a communications plan and a programme to develop self-care.
- Work to implement Social prescribing in a number of Practices across BLMK by April 2018 commenced.

Priority 2: Primary, Community and Social Care

- Engagement event held in May to launch GP 5YFW attended by over 100 people
- Working to reduce care home admissions, with targeted care plans for all people in nursing homes including a bespoke medication review
- Out of hospital strategies being developed across BLMK
- Plans to implement the NAPC's Primary Care Home Model in Clusters/Localities.



Priority 3: Sustainable Secondary Care

- Clinicians have been working together to identify ways in which some hospital services may be delivered differently, responding to the growing pressures on hospitals and the critical need to invest in out-of-hospital and social care
- *‘What we have heard so far’ report* will soon be published, which captures feedback from public, staff and clinicians during pre-engagement activity during March (consisting of public events and an online questionnaire)
- This feedback is being used to inform the Case for Change, and to help identify options that will form the basis of proposals for hospital services in the future.
- In the meantime the three hospitals are working together to identify ways to share best practice and learning, and identify opportunities for collaboration.

Priority 5: System redesign

- Initial engagement carried out across STP partners
- Submitted Expression of Interest for ‘lead ACS status’ – this is now confirmed
- Working towards a single integrated health and social care commissioning function for Luton from July, with plans for other BLMK areas to follow.
