The Council is advised that the overall number of seats to which Group is entitled on the "ordinary" committees shown in Section A of Appendix A to the report is as follows:

The Council is further advised that the Group Leaders are recommending an increase by 1 seat in the size of the Children, Families and Learning Overview and Scrutiny Committee (as shown in the table above) for the reason set out below.

Paragraph 2(b) of the report refers to the statutory requirement that the majority of seats on a committee is allocated to the majority group on the Council. In relation to the Children, Families and Learning Overview and Scrutiny Committee, the rules provide that co-opted member seats are to be taken into account in calculating what constitutes a majority of the seats.

The constitution currently provides that the Children, Families and Learning Overview and Scrutiny Committee should comprise 9 councillors and 5 coopted members (3 elected parent governors and 2 appointed church representatives), which would require the Conservative group to have 8 of the 9 seats available to councillors. The Group Leaders have proposed that the overall size of the committee (including co-opted members) be increased from 14 to 15 members, comprising 8 Conservatives, 2 Liberal Democrats and 5 co-opted members, which would meet the above requirement. To achieve this recommendation 1 should be amended to read:

1. That the Council confirms for the municipal year 2009/10:

- (a) the structure, size and terms of reference of the committees, sub-committees and joint committees set out in sections D1, E2, F1 and J2 of the Council's constitution subject to the membership of the Children, Families and Learning Overview and Scrutiny Committee being 10 councillors and substitutes, plus the 5 co-opted members; and its quorum being 4 councillors and 2 co-opted members;
- (b) the revised allocation of seats as follows:-
 - (i) Business Transformation Overview and Scrutiny Committee

Agenda Item 16: Appointments to Outside Bodies

Recommendation 3 of this report proposes extending the existing temporary appointments until 31 August 2009 or until fresh appointments are made, whichever is the earlier, where the representatives appointed in March 2009 continue to be Central Bedfordshire Council Members. This applies to 98 out of the 150 separate councillor appointments listed in the bottom row of the appended schedule of outside bodies. The other 52 appointees are former shadow councillors who are no longer elected Members.

It is proposed that, where agreed with the Group Leaders on a case by case basis, the Monitoring Officer should be authorised similarly to extend the terms of office of persons who are no longer elected Members.

Recommendation 3 of the report should therefore be amended to read:

- 3. That existing temporary appointments be extended until 31 August 2009 or until fresh appointments are made, whichever is the earlier, where either:
 - (a) the representatives appointed in March 2009 continue to be Central Bedfordshire Council Members; or
 - (b) in other cases, an extension has been agreed with the Group Leaders on a case by case basis.

fourth day after the ordinary election on 4 June 2009.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Council considers, having regard to the comments of the majority of Panel members, as set out in paragraph 7, whether to make a retrospective amendment to the Scheme of Members' Allowances for the period from 1 April to 8 June 2009, to provide a Special Responsibility Allowance for those Members of the Executive who had no Portfolio during that period.

The Members' Allowances Scheme for the Period of the Second Transitional Period

- 1. This report provides additional information to the report included as Agenda Item 17 for this meeting and advises the Council of the recommendation of the Independent Remuneration Panel for the payment of:
 - (a) an enhanced Special Responsibility Allowance for the Deputy Leader of the Council who was also Vice Chairman of the Executive but without Portfolio, and
 - (b) a Special Responsibility Allowance for those Members of the Executive without Portfolio.

- When the members of the Independent Panel were recently consulted on this matter they were made aware that the Department for Communities and Local Government, in a Statutory Instrument made on 30 March 2009, specified that those persons who, on the coming into force of the Order, were members of the Executive, should continue as members of the Executive during the second transitional period. In other words those Members appointed to the Executive at the inaugural meeting of the Shadow Council on 10 April 2008, served for both the first and second transitional periods. This information was not known to the Panel when they held meetings in September and October 2008 to consider their recommendations for the Scheme of Members' Allowances for the year commencing 1 April 2009.
- During the consultation the Panel were also made aware that the Executive, during the second transitional period, continued to discharge an enhanced range of functions because the intended range of Overview and Scrutiny Committees had not been fully developed. It was not however possible to provide details of any specific additional responsibilities that were carried out by the non portfolio members of the Executive during this period of intense activity.
- 4. Due to time constraints it was not possible to arrange for the Panel to meet formally and the consultation took the form of an exchange of correspondence.
- 5. The Panel has in the past taken the view, when considering Special Responsibility Allowances, that evidence as to the nature of the specific additional responsibilities, together with an indication as to the time commitment, needs to be available.
- 6. Having considered the current issue the Panel were unable to reach a unanimous agreement as to whether a special responsibility allowance should be paid to non portfolio members of the Executive or, whether an enhanced allowance should be paid to the Deputy Leader.
- 7. However a majority of Panel members were content with a special responsibility allowance of 7.5% of the Leader's Special Responsibility Allowance being paid to Non Portfolio Holders of the Executive, but that no additional allowance be paid for the position of Deputy Leader.
- 8. If this recommendation were to be adopted by the Council, and applied retrospectively to the Scheme of Members' Allowances, the figure paid to each non portfolio holder would be pro rata to an annual sum of £2,525 for the period from 1 April 2009 until the fourth day after the day of election, namely 8 June 2009. This equates to approximately £477 per Member and £2,386 in total.
