3 Extension of 30 mph Speed Limit on Wing Road, Linslade

This report seeks the approval of the Portfolio Holder for Safer and Stronger Communities to extend the 30 mph speed limit on Wing Road, Linslade following public consultation and reciept of an objection.

Wing Road, Linslade Proposed Traffic calming and * 17 - 50 20 mph Zone

The purpose of this report is to consider objections received as a result of statutory consultation for the proposed extension on the town centre 20 mph Zone along Wing Road as far as the railway bridge, implementation of associated traffic calming and the conversion of a pelican crossing to a zebra corssing on a raised table and to seek approval for the implementation of the project.

5 Removal of Prohibition of Cycling Order, Saxons Close to Hockliffe Road Service Road, Leighton Buzzard

This report seeks the approval of the Portfolio Holder for Safer and Stronger Communities to remove the Prohibition of Cycling Order on the footpath that extends from Saxons Close to Hockliffe Road Service Road, Leighton Buzzard following public consultation and reciept of representations.

6 C100 Ampthill Road, Maulden (Between Ampthill and * 63 - 78 Maulden) and Ailesbury Road, Ampthill

To report to the Portfolio Holdler for Safer and Stronger Communities the results of a consultation on a proposed Traffic Regulation Order to introduce a 40 mph speed limit along Ailesbury Road, Ampthill and the C100 Maulden Road, Ampthill and Ampthill Road, Maulden and to seek approval for implementation of this scheme.

7 A6 Deadman's Hill - Gap Closure, U Turn and One Way

To report to the Portfolio Holder for Safer and Stronger Communities the results of the statutory consultation on proposals to implement gap closures, no 'U' turns and one way traffic on various parts of the A6 known as Deadmans Hill and seek approval to implement the proposals on the understanding that the recommendations of the Stage 1 and subsequent Stage 2 Road Safety Audits be included within the final design.

Additionally Stage 3, Stage 4 Road Safety Audits will be undertaken on completion and after 12 months respectively with any recommendations implemented in agreement with the Client Central Bedfordshire Council.

Further consideration should be given to traffic calming measures in Haynes West End should increased traffic flows result from the future Greensand Trust development.
