SACRE/11/20 Annual Report 2010/2011

The SACRE were advised of the annual report 2010/11. The three main elements of the development plan had been split into three main elements as follows:

Development Plan
Launch of the syllabus
Religious Education Society and link between the SACRE

The Chairman sought volunteers to write a report on one of the above elements.

It was further advised that a precis of Religious education GCSE results would be incorporated in the report.

As part of the Annual report, members received a summary of the highlights from the NASACRE Annual General Meeting and information about development opportunities for RE teachers. They also noted information on the re-writing of the Local Authority's Agreed Syllabus.

SACRE/11/21 Development Plan Update

The Council received an update on the SACRE Development Plan for 2011/12, the main aim of which was to ensure that high quality Religious Education and Collective worship are delivered in Central Bedfordshire schools.

During discussion upon this item, SACRE discussed the importance of the need for encouraging Free schools and Academies to liaise with Central Bedfordshire in order to work to the agreed syllabus. It was agreed that this be discussed at the next meeting.

Reference was made to the need to work collaboratively with Bedford Borough and Luton Local Authority's to embed the revised Agreed Syllabus by providing joint training opportunities for RE teachers and subject leaders across the phases. The Chairman agreed to compile a list of training providers for schools.

The SACRE discussed the 2012 Holocaust memorial day event. It was agreed that a Working Group formed from members of SACRE be established.

Members were reminded that the Local Authority's Agreed Syllabus would be launched on 2 November 2011 at Putteridgebury, Luton.
