Waton; 1.3 a reassessment of the impact of reduced traffic on Luton Road following the reopening of the Busway. Interim Remedial / Mitigation Measures: 2.2.1 Poynters Road resurfacing with noiseless drain covers / set back drain Advisory freight route signage on Luton Road Westbound at Skimpot Roundabout and at appropriate locations on the Woodside and adjacent industrial estates. (d) No waiting times outside of Ardley Hill School of 8.00am – 09.30am and 3.00pm – 5.00pm will be reduced to 8.15am – 9.15am and 3.15pm – 4.15pm. (e) The uncontrolled dropped crossing on Langdale Road west of Lowther Road will be omitted. 3.
