That the proposal to introduce Residents Permit Parking and No Waiting at any time in Grove Road, Leighton Buzzard be implemented as published, with the exception that property nos. 34, 36 and 40 Lake Street be removed from the list of residences eligible to apply for a permit. 3. That the proposal to introduce Waiting Restrictions in Grasmere Way, Leighton-Linslade be implemented as published, with the exception that the length of Grasmere Way between nos. 72 & 82 and nos. 152 & 162 not be implemented at this time.
