**CASUALTY REDUCTION**

The Chair thanked Basil Jackson for the informative presentation.

- Basil Jackson to circulate statistical figures to members of this meeting forum for the accidents that happen on the M1 and A1.
- The age group for motor cycle accidents.
- Devise an Educational Action Plan that will include other national agencies such as the Department for Transport and Universities also, to educate groups on road safety. This is to include accidents due to drug dependency.
- Produce accident stats related to winter maintenance
- Try to gain understanding of near misses in an attempt to reduce potential accidents.
- Ensure there is a member on the operational delivery group of the CSP.
- Identify where road safety education could be better joined up. E.g. Clive Seall (Youth offending Team) explained that his service offered training for young motorcycle offenders and was unaware of training provided through the highways road safety team.
- Richard Newcombe requested clarification regarding which agency received the application costs after a guilty plea is entered. Neil Wilson of Bedfordshire Police to investigate and advise of outcome at next CSP Exec meeting.
