AGENDA ITEM UPDATE – THE WHITE SWAN, REVIEW OF PREMISES LICENCE

On 21 July 2010 we received an email from the Environmental Health Officer who was on call out over the weekend which stated that he received a complaint from a resident in the vicinity, complaining about loud music.

He visited the complainant's property at 2am and could clearly hear general noise, loud voices and shouting at a level which would materially affect the use and enjoyment of the complainant's home and prevent a person sleeping or wake a person.

He went to the White Swan where loud music was playing from amplified speakers in the pub (These went off at 2.10am), and loud customers in the garden, which is surrounded by residential properties.

The Environmental Health Officer suggests that in order to minimise the impact on residents, the licence conditions be amended as follows:

- No music to be heard from nearby residential properties after 11.30 at the weekend, and earlier in the week.
- Premises to close at midnight, or persons not allowed in the garden after midnight.
