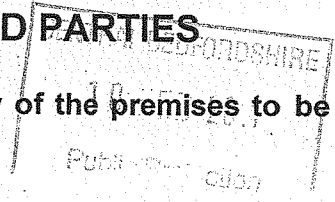

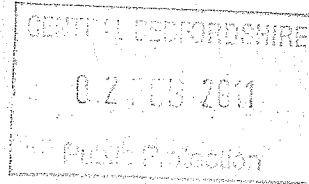

It has come to our notice that there is a proposal by Mr Duzgun Yilmaz to open the currently closed Coffee House from 23:00 until midnight from Sunday through to Thursday and from 23:00 until 02:00 on Friday and Saturday.
