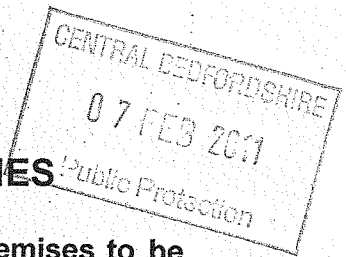

Application for premises licence at 14A Woburn Street, Ampthill

A notice in the window of 14A Woburn Street informs us that Mr Duzgun Yilmas has applied for a premises licence for these premises. We understand that this licence, if granted, would allow the sale of take-away food from 2300 until midnight from Sunday through to Thursday and from 2300 until 0200 on Fridays and Saturdays. In addition, on every Sunday before a Bank Holiday the premises would be open until 0200.

These premises are situated within a residential area, its adjoining properties being private dwellings. We think that it is quite unacceptable to allow the sale of take-away foods from these premises at the night-time hours proposed and strongly object to this application.
