REG/09/46 Health and Safety (as a Regulator) Service Plan 2011-2012

The Committee received and considered the report of the Director of Sustainable Communities which requested the Committee to endorse the Health and Safety (as a Regulator) Service Plan 2011 – 12 (a copy of which was appended to the report) and forward any comments to the Executive for consideration.
