Recommendation

That Planning Permission be refused

- The application site is in an unsustainable location, outside of any defined settlement envelope, with no access to public transport. The proposal would therefore be contrary to local and national planning policies which seek to restrict new development in the countryside; as such the proposal is contrary to national planning policies PPS1, PPS7 and PPG13. In addition to this it is contrary to Policy CS4 of the Core Strategy and Development Management Policies for Central Bedfordshire (North).
- The proposed development, by nature of its location outside any defined Settlement Envelope, would have an unacceptable impact on the character and appearance of this rural area where restrictive Planning Policies apply; as such the proposal is contrary to PPS7 and Policy DM3 and DM4 of the Core Strategy and Development Management Policies for Central Bedfordshire (North).
- No technical information has been submitted in relation to noise and fumes from the proposed development to demonstrate that the proposal would not have an unacceptable impact on the residential amenities of properties within the vicinity. Therefore the proposal fails to demonstrate that there would be no detrimental impact on the residential amenities of properties within the vicinity and is therefore contrary to Policy DM3 of the Core Strategy and Development Management Policies for Central Bedfordshire (North).
