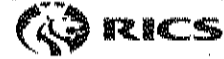

**Planning Application: Plots 2, 2A, 3 Woodside Caravan park, Hatch, Sandy, SG19 1PT**

I am writing further to my letter of 16 June objecting on behalf of residents of Hatch.

Thank you for sending me scanned copies of the missing appendices accompanying this planning application.

I make no comment on Apps. 5 & 6. These do not add anything significant to the information supporting the application.

With regard to Appendix 3, this sets out the special health and education needs of some of the occupants of the site. I do not wish to refer to specific cases. The residents of Hatch are sympathetic to these special circumstances in respect of some of the occupants. The residents of Hatch would not want the occupants of Woodside to be denied these services.

However the site review process already carried out by the council and nearly completed has identified additional pitch potential. The health and education needs can be met by the Oak Tree Nursery and Magpie Farm at Upper Caldecote because they are a similar distance from those facilities. This is an identified site for 3 pitches and therefore would enable the named residents to continue to receive these services. Those are authorised sites unlike the application pitches which do not have permanent planning permission.

Please can you make these representations available to the Development Management Committee when it considers the application on 22 June.
