Schools Adjudicator will be the decision maker in the first instance only if the proposal is "related" to another proposal which falls to be determined by the schools adjudicator. The adjudicator will also be the decision maker if the proposal is decided by the LA but then a specified body requests that the decision be referred to the adjudicator, or, if the LA fail to determine the proposals within 2 months of the end of the representation period.
