	Background			
2.	The Constitution Advisory Group at its meeting on 27 January 2012 considered amending the Ethical Handbook with regard to Member requests for site visits on planning applications to be considered by the Development Management Committee.			
3.	The Head of Development Management advised that currently there was no requirement for requests for site visits to be supported by any justification.			
4.	Members noted that, whilst site visits by Members could help them understand the full position relating to a planning application, maximum benefit would be achieved if the Member calling for the site visit made clear the factors that had lead to the request. In this way the site visit could be focused to ensure consideration was given to those factors.
