2.	by the He appointm with Bedf and the fi Members Act 2011 connectio	eeting on 2 August 2012 the Committee considered a report ead of Legal and Democratic Services regarding the nent of a joint panel of independent persons in collaboration ford Borough, Luton Borough and Milton Keynes Councils fire authorities for Buckinghamshire and Bedfordshire. s were aware that it was a requirement under the Localism to appoint such persons for the purposes of consultation in on with the investigation and determination of complaints to the Code of Conduct.		
3.	local pres to be an i shortlistin	neeting noted that, following the placing of advertisements in the press and on the respective Councils' websites, 21 applications an independent person had been received. Following isting 13 applicants had been interviewed from which 10 had recommended for appointment.		
4.	The Head of Legal and Democratic Services drew Members' attention to the transitional provisions implemented by the government which would have the effect of allowing a former independent Member of Central Bedfordshire Council's Standards Committee to act as an independent person for the Council until 30 June 2013 only. He also commented on the need to agree the detailed terms and conditions for the independent persons and provide necessary training.			
5.	With regard to the provision of training for the independent persons the Head of Legal and Democratic Services stated that there would, in the meantime, be a need to process the Code of Conduct complaints that had already been received. As such it would be necessary to make use of those independent persons who had already gained training and experience as independent Members under the previous Standards regime until all appointees had received training on the new regulations.
