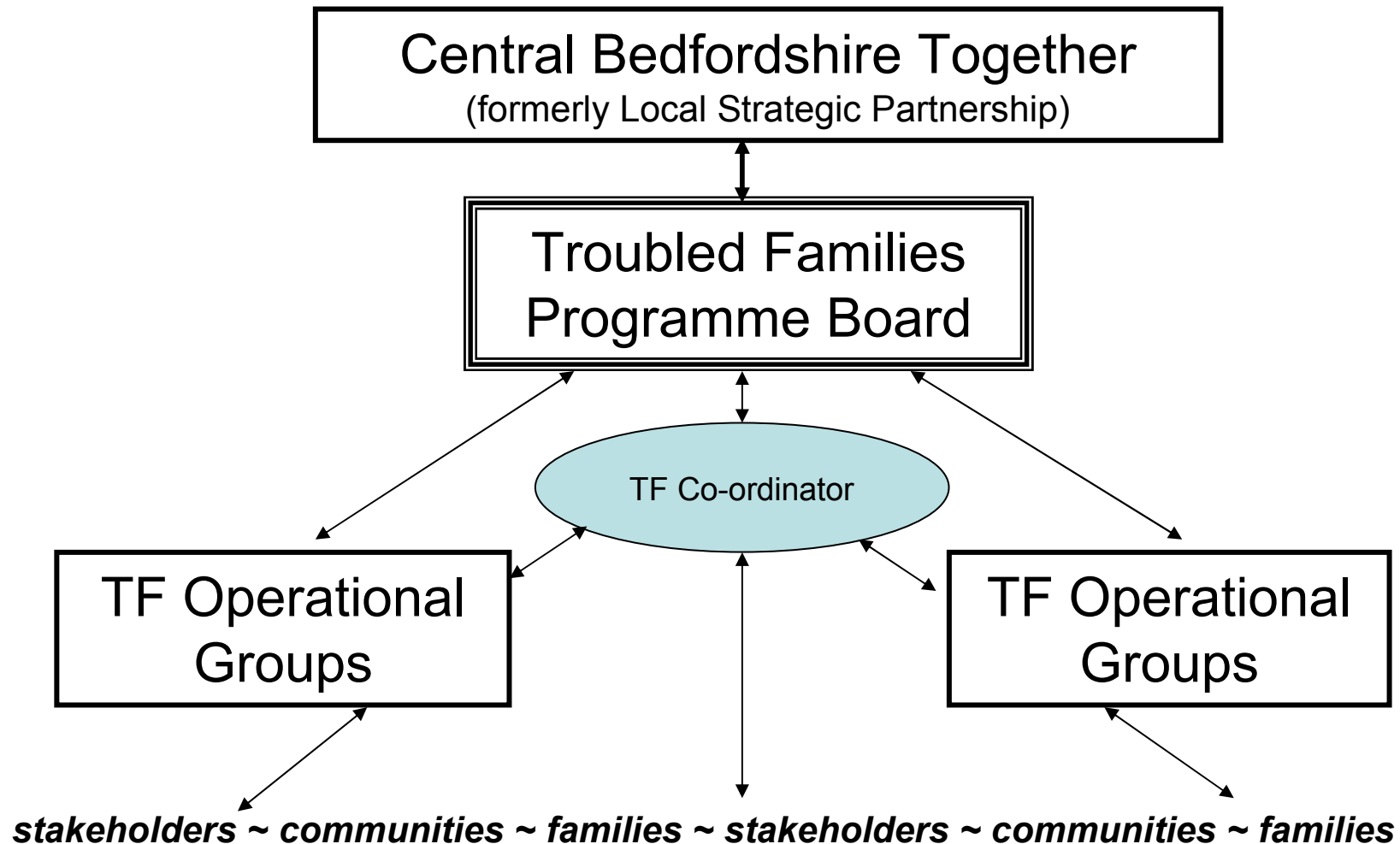
# Troubled Families ...
