Bedfordshire Police have received a temporary event notice from Alyssia Head for the Hq Sports Bar, Unit 5&6 Grove Park, Court Drive, Dunstable, LU5 4GP, The temporary event notice is for 2nd May 2015 to 3rd May 2015 from 03:30 to 08.00hrs for the screening of a Boxing Match at the venue which will be aired outside of their licensed Hours. Bedfordshire Police is therefore objecting to this application under the four licensing objectives as follows:

1. The Prevention of Crime and Disorder
2. Public Safety
3. The Prevention of Public Nuisance

Bedfordshire Police are objecting to this Temporary event notice due to the following:

On Thursday 26th February The HQ Sports Bar were placed on an action plan due to the concerns and incidents that have taken place at the venue

On the 1st March Fight took place at the Hq sports Bar whereby the Door staff were struggling to deal with the situation as a result of this bottles were being used.

On the 8th of March Public Disorder started in the HQ Sports Bar and then Spilled into Grove house Gardens, One Victim received GBH injuries and 5 persons were arrested, the Manager/ Doorstaff were unhelpful and did not have control of the situation.

Lack of co-operation from the Doorstaff has been an issue and still continues to be an issue and concern for this venue.

The lack of knowledge and experience from the DPS and managers who work within the HQ Sports Bar is also a concern, understanding the licence and adhering to licence and that is why

Bedfordshire Police are therefore concerned that with this event coming up the licensing objectives would be undermine and therefore that is why we are objecting to this Temporary Event Notice Taking place.
