| Prevention of public nuisance | Yes | <p>I am not satisfied that the applicant has demonstrated that the proposed activities will prevent public noise nuisance to neighbouring residents. The applicant has applied for live music inside and on the field on Sundays to Thursdays from 0900 hrs to 2330 hrs and Fridays/Saturdays from 0900hrs to 0000 hrs . They have also applied for recorded music inside and on the field on Sundays to Thursdays from 0900 hrs to 2400 hrs and Fridays/Saturdays 0900 hrs to 0100 hrs.</p> <p>I am particularly concerned about the noise impact of events in the field upon neighbours. The proposed conditions (asking patrons to leave quietly and keeping doors and windows closed during events) whilst welcome will not sufficiently control outside event noise.</p> <p>I am not satisfied that orientating speakers away from the premises would be sufficient to ensure that music noise is not excessive at neighbouring premises. In my experience music from events in marquees and gardens can impact residents over 1km away and music noise will break out in all directions, albeit that the highest volume will be in front of the speakers.</p> |
