

Grant Aid Scheme - Talented Individuals

Grant Criteria

Who can apply?

Talented Individuals living within Central Bedfordshire, not in full time employment, who
have reached a high standard of achievement within their field with the potential to go
further.

What projects/activities will be considered?

- All applications will be based on individual merit but should be within the areas of:
 - Arts Development
 - Sports Development
 - Play Development
- Applications for funding to help with various key costs which may include:
 - Training costs leading to a specific event or competition
 - o Travel and equipment costs associated with a specific event or competition
 - Fees associated with specialised training sessions/workshops
 - o Specialist equipment such as musical instruments, sports kit, ballet shoes
- All applications must be relevant to at least one of the Council's priorities for 2009/11 which are:
 - Supporting and caring for an ageing population.
 - Educating, protecting and providing opportunities for children and young people.
 - Managing growth effectively.
 - Creating safer communities
 - Promoting healthier lifestyles.

How much can be applied for?

- Up to £250 in any 12 month period.
- The amount awarded per applicant will be dependent upon the number of applications received.

 No on-going commitment can be given for grants in any subsequent years however individuals who can demonstrate they have developed or improved since their previous application can reapply.

What conditions will apply?

The applicant must

- o Be able to demonstrate the need for financial assistance
- Provide a recommendation from a recognised coach, mentor or an established performer confirming their potential to achieve a higher standard within their chosen field.
- For Sports Development awards the applicant must be a member of a club that is affiliated to the relevant governing body.

Other considerations

- Applicants will be expected to contribute in cash or in kind towards the project/equipment.
- Any grant aid received from Central Bedfordshire Council must be acknowledged and publicised whenever and wherever possible
- Applicants will be required to complete a declaration form before any grant aid award is paid.
- All successful applicants will be required to complete a feedback form and provide both relevant receipts and evidence of any publicity, within six months of the award being paid.

What will we not fund?

- Sportsmen and women who are already in receipt of support from their sport's governing body.
- Sportsmen and women who may qualify for free leisure centre membership via the British Olympic Association.
- Education fees and related expenses e.g. Drama college, University fees etc.
- Individuals who are already in receipt of a grant or donation from any other Central Bedfordshire Council source within the same twelve month period.
- Any retrospective activity or any activity that will take place before the application is considered.
- Normal on going expenses such as travel to training sessions, club fees, membership fees

What is the timescale?

- Meetings are held four times per year to consider applications.
- The deadline date for the return of completed application forms will be not less than one month prior to the date of the meeting.
- Applications received after this date will be referred to the following meeting.
